

Behold the <u>Lamb</u> of God who takes away the <u>sins</u> of the world. *John 1:29*





Peace (Lev 3,7): Voluntary offering and meal of thanks

Sin (Lev 4-7)

<u>Guilt:</u> Mandatory when guilty for loss, provides forgiveness & atonement <u>Sin:</u> Mandatory when guilty, provides forgiveness & atonement <u>Jesus became sin for us so that we can be made righteous. 2 Cor 5:21</u>

Why so much blood?

1. Forgiveness required blood

Without the shedding of <u>blood</u> there is no <u>forgiveness</u> of sins. *Hebrews 9:22*

The life of a creature is in its <u>blood</u>. *Leviticus 17:11*

Impossible for the blood of <u>bulls</u> and <u>goats</u> to take away sins. *Hebrews 10:4*
